NVP Code of conduct

Code of conduct

- NVP members will conduct themselves with the **highest standards of integrity and honesty**. 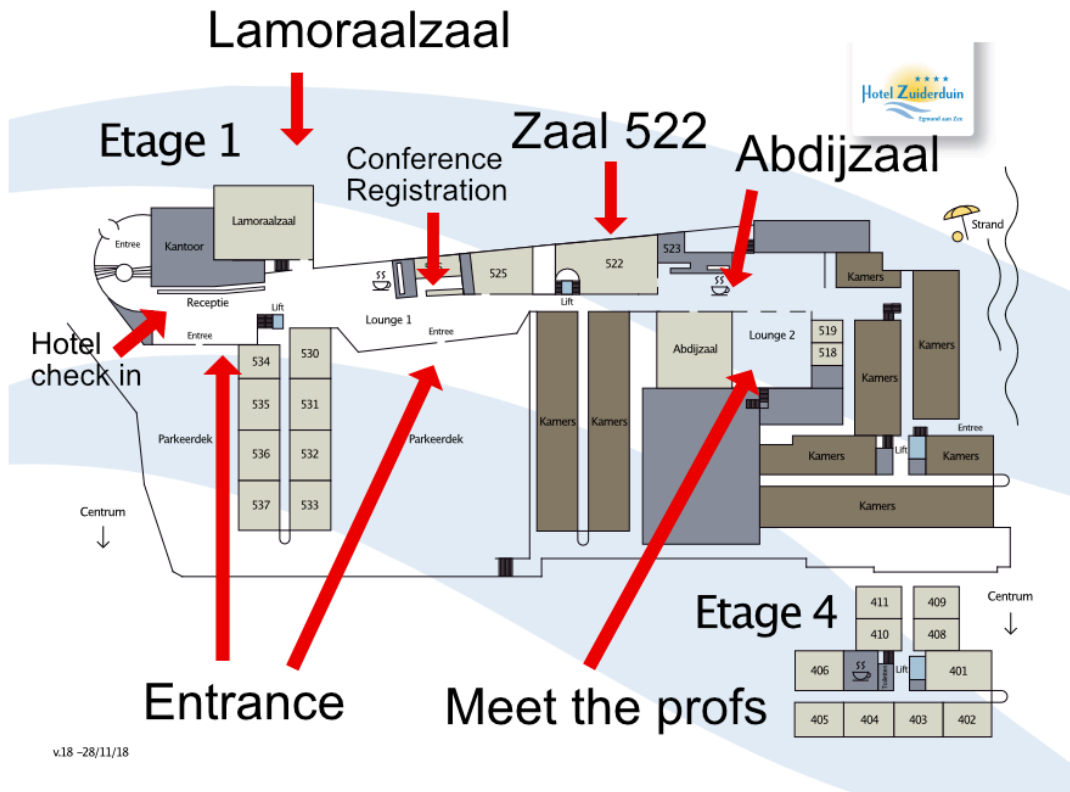

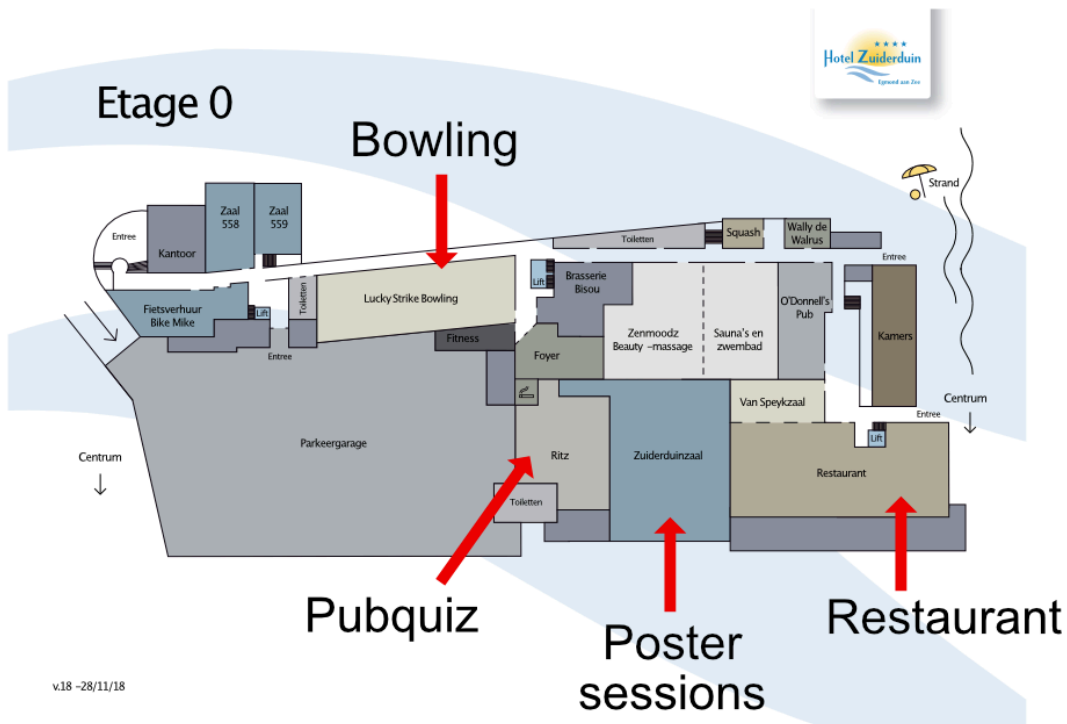
